THE OPENING TIP

- After picking up their first win over High Point in the Jayson Gee era earlier this season, the Lancers host the Panthers Wednesday in Willett Hall.
- Longwood outlasted High Point 60-55 on the road in the first meeting this season for the second win of a three-game win streak.
- Longwood is down to just seven available scholarship players after a rash of injuries. Most recently, redshirt sophomore point guard Bryan Gee was shut down for the season due to prolonged overtraining syndrome stemming from offseason surgery. Damarion Geter (broken foot), Jahleem Montague (torn ACL) and Juan Munoz (torn ACL) are also on the team's long-term injury report, while Kendrick Thompson will miss the remainder of the year due to academic reasons.
- Senior guard Darrion Allen is just 20 points shy of reaching 1,000 for his career.

LAST TIME OUT

- In a showdown of two of the Big South's top big men, Presbyterian forward Ed Drew poured in 21 points and grabbed nine rebounds to power the Blue Hose past Longwood 71-62 Saturday evening in the Templeton Center.
- Drew did the bulk of his damage from the free throw line, hitting 9-of-13 free throws as Presbyterian avenged the Lancers' 79-76 win in the first meeting between the teams on Jan. 4.
- Drew's performance was enough to overcome a 16-point, 11-rebound double-double from his foil in the paint, Khrist Lane, who played all 40 minutes for short-handed Longwood.
- Drew scored 11 of his points in the second half to hold off a late charge by the Lancers, who trailed by just two points with 9:51 to play.
- Longwood also got 13 points from senior guard Darrion Allen and 12 from Chris Shields.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Due to a rash of injuries, Longwood has leaned on just six players to shoulder the bulk of the team's minutes. The Lancers have five players averaging at least 20.0 minutes per game and three — **Darrion Allen** (35.6 mpg.), **Khris Lane** (33.3) and **Isaiah Walton** (31.2) — averaging at least 30.0 minutes per game.
- Khris Lane** is Longwood's leading scorer in the second half of games this season, averaging 9.0 points over the game's final 20 minutes. He shoots .561 (74-of-132) from the field and .441 (15-of-34) from three-point range in the second half and has scored at least 10 points in the second half a team-high eight times this season.
- Lane has scored in double figures in 10 consecutive games and leads Longwood with 17 double-digit scoring games.
- Darrion Allen** is just 20 points shy of reaching 1,000 points for his career. A member of head coach Jayson Gee's first recruiting class at Longwood, He would become the sixth 1,000-point scorer of the school's Division I era and the 21st in program history.
- Longwood ranks second in the Big South with 4.1 blocks per game and has three players — **JaShaun Smith** (5th, 1.3 bpg.), **Khris Lane** (6th, 1.1 bpg.) and **Darrion Allen** (9th, 0.9 bpg.) — ranked in the top 10 in blocks per game.
- Smith, Lane and Allen have as many or more combined blocks (65) than five Big South teams.
- After carding just two double-digit scoring games in his first 20 outings, sophomore forward **Chris Shields** has scored in double figures in back-to-back games. Shields started Longwood's last game at Presbyterian on Jan. 28 and played a career-high 38 minutes, scoring 12 points.
- Longwood is 4-0 when outrebounding the opposition this season, including all three Big South wins.
- Freshman forward **JaShaun Smith** has a block in 12 consecutive games.

- Longwood and High Point meet for the second time this season and 29th time in series history Wednesday.
- The Lancers took the first meeting of the 2016-17 season, 60-55, on New Year's Eve in High Point, N.C. That win was Longwood's first over the Panthers under fourth-year head coach Jayson Gee and the program's second in the five-year Big South era.
- Khris Lane** scored 18 points and grabbed seven rebounds in the last meeting against the Panthers.

LANCERS EYEING BIG SOUTH CLIMB FOR FOURTH STRAIGHT YEAR

- Longwood is looking to improve its spot in the Big South standings for the fourth consecutive year.
- The Lancers have improved on their conference finish from the previous season in each of head coach Jayson Gee's first three seasons, moving from 11th place in 2013-14 to ninth in 2014-15 to a program-best eighth in 2015-16.
- This year's Longwood squad jumped out to the program's best start in Big South history, winning their first three conference games to open the season as the conference's last remaining unbeaten team before preseason favorite Winthrop handed them their first conference loss.
- Longwood's three-game Big South win streak was the longest since joining the league five years ago.
- Longwood's 3-7 start through 10 Big South games ties the 2014-15 squad's 10-game start as the best in the five-year Division I era.

- Due to a rash of injuries, Longwood has relied on the trio of **Darrion Allen**, **Isaiah Walton** and **Khris Lane** to shoulder the bulk of the team's minutes.
- Each of those three ranks among the Big South's top 10 in minutes per game, including Allen who leads the conference with a career-high 35.6.
- With only seven scholarship players available, the Lancers have five players averaging at least 21.0 minutes per game and another — senior **Isaac Belton** — averaging 24.5 minutes in Big South play.

THE BIG THREE

- Longwood has gotten the bulk of its production from the trio of guards **Darrion Allen** and **Isaiah Walton**, and forward **Khris Lane**. Each of those three ranks among the Big South's top 15 in scoring and minutes per game, making Longwood the Big South's only team with three players in the top 15 in either of those categories.
- Lane (16.4 ppg.), Allen (14.1) and Walton (13.2) combine to average 43.7 points per game, or 65.3 percent of Longwood's total scoring. They have accounted for 50 of Longwood's 65 double-figure scoring games.
- Those three rank as the third-highest scoring trio in the Big South, trailing only Campbell and Winthrop.
- Longwood is 5-5 when each of those three score in double figures in the same game.

LANE OWNS THE LANE

- Former Drexel transfer Khris Lane ranks among the Big South's top double-double threats and among the league's most versatile forwards.
- Lane ranks among the league's top five in scoring (5th, 16.4 ppg.) rebounding (4th, 7.4 rpg.), double-doubles (4th, 5) and field goal percentage (2nd, .532 — 140-of-263).
- Lane has showcased his range as well, shooting .333 (20-of-60) from three-point range with at least one trey in 11 of his 21 games.
- After averaging 8.7 points per game in 2015-16, Lane has nearly doubled that production this season with 16.4 points per game, tied for the largest scoring jump in the Big South this season.
- Lane has accounted for 23.8 percent of Longwood's rebounds this season and has led the team in rebounding 15 times. Longwood is 3-2 this season when he has a double-double.
- Lane tied Longwood's Division I single-game rebound record last season with 20 boards against Randolph on Nov. 13, 2015.

- Geter is also a representative on the Student Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC).

FRESHMAN JaSHAUN SMITH SEIZES OPPORTUNITY

- Freshman forward JaShaun Smith was thrust into the starting lineup following an injury to starter Damarion Geter and has answered the call, emerging as one of the Big South's top freshmen.
- Smith ranks fifth in the Big South with 1.3 blocks per game and is the league's fifth-leading freshman scorer with 7.4 points per game despite playing just five minutes in his first three games.
- In 18 games since Geter's injury, Smith is averaging 8.1 points, 3.7 rebounds, 1.4 blocks and 27.7 minutes per game. He has scored in double figures in six of those outings is shooting .522 (12-of-23) from long range during that span.

Jayson Gee is in his fourth year at Longwood University and enters the 2016-17 season after leading the Lancers to the Big South Championship semifinals two years ago. Under Gee, Longwood has set program highs for overall wins and Big South victories in the Division I era that began prior to the 2012-13 season.

Gee, who received the 2015 Jon Lotz Barnabas Award from the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, is a 27-year coaching veteran who was named among the nation's top 10 assistant coaches at Cleveland State by BleacherReport.com before his appointment as Longwood's head coach on April 3, 2013.

With Division I stints as associate head coach at Cleveland State (2006-13), St. Bonaventure (2003-06) and Ohio (1993-96), an assistant coach post at Youngstown State (1989-93) and head coach experience at his alma mater, Division II Charleston (1996-2003), Gee has led programs to a 195-140 record as head coach. He has coached those teams to six NCAA Tournaments, including the 2009 postseason after helping lead Cleveland State past Butler in the Horizon League Championship.

Among Gee's most notable coaching accomplishments is the recruitment and mentoring of two-time NBA Champion Norris Cole at Cleveland State. Gee signed Cole to the Cleveland State program and coached the 6-2, 175-pound point guard to Horizon League MVP honors in 2011 before the Chicago Bulls drafted him with the 28th overall pick of the 2011 draft. Cole has since gone on to earn two championship rings with the Miami Heat and is currently a member of the New Orleans Pelicans.

Gee has significant experience in rebuilding programs after reviving his alma mater, University of Charleston, as head coach and Cleveland State as associate head coach. At both stops, Gee inherited programs with consecutive losing seasons and turned them into conference champions and NCAA Tournament participants by his third year.

Gee's rebuilding project at Longwood is on a similar track to those at Charleston and Cleveland State. In his third season, Gee led the Lancers their highest Big South finish, bolstered by five conference wins including a 15-point upset over reigning Big South champion Coastal Carolina. The Lancers earned the No. 8 seed in the Big South Tournament – the program's highest post-season seed in four years in the conference – and advanced to the Big South quarterfinals for the second straight year following a first-round win over No. 9 seed Charleston Southern.

Gee's third year also saw the development of redshirt senior center Lotanna Nwogbo, who came to Longwood as part of Gee's first recruiting class and became the program's first All-Big South first team selection in 2015-16. Nwogbo led the Big South in rebounding and double-doubles and was among the league's top 10 in scoring, field goal percentage and blocks.

Nwogbo was part of a vaunted senior class that Gee put together for 2015-16, which also included 2015 Big South All-Tournament Team selection Shaquille Johnson and the starting

backcourt duo of Leron Fisher and Tra'Vaughn White. Johnson's two-year career as a Lancer culminated in the State Farm College Slam Dunk Championship, where he represented Longwood University on a national stage as one of eight participants in the nationally televised contest on ESPN.

In 2014-15, Gee's second season at Longwood, Gee took a group of players that had spent just two seasons together and coached them to a postseason surge that included a quarter-final upset of Big South No. 1 seed Charleston in Conway, S.C. Led by All-Big South second team selection Quincy Taylor and Johnson, the Lancers won three of their final four games, including two in the Big South tournament to advance to the league semifinal for the first time in program history.

Taylor, who transferred to Longwood from UAB prior to the 2013-14 season, blossomed under Gee in his final year of college basketball, leading the Lancers with 17.2 points per game and breaking the school record with a .480 (86-of-179) three-point shooting percentage. In three seasons at UAB, including a starting gig as a sophomore, Taylor averaged just 4.1 points and

shot.340 (71-of-209) from three-point range.

The success in Gee's second season followed his 2013-14 coaching debut in which the Lancers recorded the biggest win in the program's Division I history when they defeated TCU 82-79 in Forth Worth, Texas, in just the second game of the season. That win saw point guard Lucas Woodhouse sink a buzzer-beating three-pointer with just 1.7 seconds on the clock for Longwood's first win over a BCS school.

The 2013-14 season also saw the emergence of senior swingman Tristan Carey, who went on to earn All-Big South honorable mention honors after averaging 18.5 points and 6.6 rebounds per game.

During Gee's time at Cleveland State, he helped the program to an overall record of 136-100, including four 20-win seasons and four postseason appearances. The Vikings won the 2009 Horizon League Tournament Championship and received an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament where they upset Wake Forest in the first round. Cleveland State won the Horizon League regular season in 2011 for one of three NIT berths, also accomplishing that feat in 2008 and 2012.

Gee spent three years at St. Bonaventure (2003-06), including two seasons as the associate head coach (2004-06). Prior to that, he was the head coach and assistant athletics director at his alma mater, the University of Charleston (W.Va.), leading the Division II program to a seven-year record of 160-55 that included six, 20-win campaigns, five West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC) Tournament Final appearances and four NCAA Tournament bids.

Gee was an associate head coach at Ohio University during 1995-96 after two years as an assistant coach from 1993-95,

serving an important role in the development of Gary Trent, a first-round NBA draft pick of the Milwaukee Bucks, who played a combined nine seasons in Portland, Toronto, Dallas and Minnesota. The Bobcats won the 1994 Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship, advancing to the NCAA Tournament before winning the preseason NIT Tournament the following year.

Gee began his collegiate coaching career at Youngstown State University in Ohio, spending four years (1989-93) with the Penguins after becoming one of the youngest Division I assistant coaches in the country at age 23 in 1989.

Gee was one of 18 selected for the 2008 ACE (Achieving Coaching Excellence) Program in Indianapolis. Sponsored by the NCAA Black Coaches and Administrators Council, the ACE Program is committed to preparing minority collegiate coaches for success as future head coaches.

The Springfield, Ohio, native played four years at Charleston, helping the program to a record of 92-30, including 30-5 during his sophomore season. A two-year team captain, Gee finished his collegiate career at Charleston third in rebounds (844) and games played (122). He was inducted into the Charleston Athletics Hall of Fame in 2008, after previously being inducted into the Springfield South High School Hall of Fame in 2000.

Gee earned his bachelor of science degree in social science education from Charleston in 1988, and his master of science degree in sport science and administration from Ohio University in 2003.

Jayson and his wife, Lynette, have two sons, Brandon and Bryan, and a daughter, Briana. Bryan is a redshirt sophomore on the Longwood basketball team.




