BUC NOTES

THE STORY - Charleston Southern and Longwood meet in the Big South Championship for the third straight year. The Lancers upset the top-seeded Bucs in 2015 and rallied from a 12-point first half deficit to win an 8-9 game a year ago. CSU is looking for its first Big South Championship win since defeating Campbell in a first round game on March 5, 2014. That victory earned CSU a date with top-seeded and eventual tournament champion Coastal Carolina, a game it lost 73-68 in double overtime. The winner of Tuesday's game will advance to play top-seeded Winthrop on its homecourt in Thursday's quarterfinals.

YOU LOOK FAMILIAR - CSU and Longwood will be playing for the second time in four days. The Bucs beat the Lancers, 86-78, in Farmville on Saturday to finish the regular season with wins in three of their final four regular season games. CSU led 47-27 at halftime and by 22 early in the second half before Longwood staged a furious rally to draw within 66-65 at the 6:24 mark. Christian Keeling scored four straight points, though, sparking a 7-0 spurt that helped enable the Bucs to hold on. CSU led wire-to-wire in a 76-61 win over Longwood at the Buc Dome on Jan. 21. Keeling tallied 28 points to lead the way as the Bucs led by as much as 18 to break a three-game losing streak in the series.

KEELING LOOKING TO ADD TO HUGE FRESHMAN YEAR - Christian Keeling enters the Big South Championship just ten points shy of becoming the sixth freshman in the league's 33-year history to score 500 points. He was named to the All-Big South Freshman Team and earned Honorable Mention All-Conference honors on Monday. Keeling has already set a CSU freshman scoring record and leads all league freshmen in scoring (4th overall) and rebounding (6th overall). He is the only freshman in the country to lead his team in both categories, lead all league freshman in both and rank top-ten league-wide in both.

YOUNG BUCS SHOWING PROGRESS - CSU has seven newcomers on its roster this year (effectively eight, counting redshirt freshman Antwan Maxwell). The Bucs struggled early in the season but went 7-7 after an 0-4 Big South start and finished with wins in three of their final four regular season games. Barclay Radebaugh's club starts two freshmen and a sophomore and will return all five starters next year, along with 78 percent of its scoring and 84 percent of its rebounding to date.

MAXWELL MAKING STRIDES - Antwan Maxwell scored a career-high 15 points in Saturday's win at Longwood. Maxwell nine of the final ten games of his freshman season and displayed the potential he possesses in his 6-7 frame, averaging 7.8 points and 4.1 rebounds per game during that time. He scored in double figures three times, with CSU winning two of those games.

POSTSEASON BALL AT THE BUC DOME - CSU will be playing its second-ever Big South Championship game at the Buc Dome 15 years to the date of the first. CSU hosted Elon in the opening round of the Big South tournament on Feb. 28, 2002, falling, 83-64.

2016 Big South Tournament Results

1st Round: No. 8 Longwood 75, No. 9 Charleston Southern 69 (3/3/16)

BUIES CREEK, N.C. – Charleston Southern freshman Armel Potter poured in a career-high 28 points, but Longwood rallied from an early 12-point deficit to down the Bucs, 75-69, in the first round of the 2016 Big South Men's Basketball Championship.

CSU (9-21) led for the first 32 minutes of the game before a late scoring drought undid a solid performance. Longwood (10-22) held CSU scoreless for a 5:57 stretch, and limited the Bucs to 31 percent shooting in the second half to advance into Friday's quarterfinals. The Lancers will take on top-seeded High Point Friday at noon.

CSU got off to more than an ideal start, racing to a 10-0 lead in the opening 3:02. Behind Potter and a bevy of forced turnovers out of their zone defense, the Bucs built their edge to 18-6 by the 13:40 mark. Potter was 4-for-4 overall and 2-for-2 from three-point range in that torrid opening sequence, showcasing the form that made him a member of the Big South All-Freshman Team.

Darrion Allen tallied Longwood's first 13 points to help the Lancers weather that early storm. He scored 20 of his 22 points in the opening stanza as Longwood entered intermission trailing just 44-39 despite 18 points from Potter and 57 percent CSU shooting.

Longwood took its first lead on a Tra'Vaughn White three with 7:47 remaining. Potter scored on a drive to give CSU the lead back on its next possession but the Bucs would not score again until Aaron Wheeler dropped in a put back with 1:27 left. Wheeler added a free throw to complete a three-point play and bring CSU within two, but Shaq Johnson connected on a spinning layup on Longwood's next possession to re-instate a two-score lead.

Longwood shot 50 percent for the game and placed five players in double figures scoring to oust CSU from the Big South Tournament for the second consecutive year. The Lancers out-rebounded the Bucs, 41-21, and accumulated a 17-5 edge in second chance points.

"Congratulations to Longwood because they did a good job of overcoming our early stretch and took advantage of our size, particularly in the second half," Radebaugh said. "I thought we played really well for 30-35 minutes and moved the ball and made shots. We didn't make enough shots down the stretch, and they made more plays when they had to."

"I was proud of our effort, and have been happy with the way our guys have responded throughout the year," continued Radebaugh. "Certainly our season didn't go the way it has in the past and the way we've become accustomed to – competing for regular season championships and being in the race – but our guys came to work every day and stayed positive. I'm excited about what we're adding next year, and am looking forward to getting back, improving, and getting back in the hunt next season."

Potter buried a career-high six treys, and was 11-of-17 from the field in total. His 414 points are the most by a CSU freshman since Saah Nimley recorded 420 in 2011-12. Wheeler posted 21 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals in his final collegiate game.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - AHMAD THOMAS, UNC ASHEVILLE, G. JR (DANVILLE, VA.)

Thomas averaged 28.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.5 steals last week. He was 24-of-36 from the field (=66.7 percent), including 5-of-7 from three-point range (=71.4). Thomas started his week with 25 points, five boards, three steals and an assist against Gardner-Webb, and concluded with a career-high 31 points, six rebounds and four helpers in the Bulldogs' win over Liberty Saturday to clinch the Big South regular-season co-championship.

THE COME READY NUTRITION FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CHRISTIAN KEELING, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, G. FR (AUGUSTA, GA.)

Keeling posted averages of 20.0 points and 10.5 rebounds for the Buccaneers. He opened with 28 points and career-high 13 boards at Winthrop, and followed with 12 points and eight caroms in Saturday's win at Longwood. Keeling scored four straight crucial points with six minutes left to help CSU pull away in the second half. For the week, he was 11-of-25 from the floor (=44.0) and made 75 percent of his free throw attempts (18-of-24).

Preseason Notes

- **Canada trip a rousing success:** Charleston Southern went a perfect 3-0 on its summer tour of Canada, defeating Windsor University and Humber College convincingly before edging the University of Toronto in a tight contest. Toronto defeated UNLV shortly after the Bucs handed them a defeat on their home floor. NCAA rules allow for a foreign tour once every four years. CSU coach Barclay Radebaugh previously took teams to Poland (2008) and the Dominican Republic (2012).
- **Newcomers excel on Canada trip:** CSU will lean heavily on contributions from seven newcomers (eight, counting redshirt freshman Antwan Maxwell) and several of those players stood out this August in Canada. Freshman guard Christian Keeling was CSU's leading scorer at 18 points per game, scored 24 points in a rout of Windsor and capped the trip with a 19 point, four rebound, four steal effort against Toronto. Cortez Mitchell, a transfer from Pearl River Community College, tallied a team-high 18 points in a thorough 83-63 win over Humber College. Antwan Maxwell recorded ten points and seven rebounds in the Toronto game.
- **Potter looking to build off big freshman year:** Guard Armel Potter earned All-Big South Freshman Team honors after leading CSU in scoring, assists, field goals made and attempted, free throws made and attempted, steals and minutes per game. Potter led all Big South freshmen in assists and assist-to-turnover ratio and ranked third in scoring.
- **Howard developing as interior presence:** Javis Howard played his best basketball of the season late last year, averaging 12.9 PPG and 7.0 RPG while shooting 57 percent over a six-game stretch from Jan. 23-Feb. 11. Howard has added at least ten pounds of muscle to his frame, and was efficient while reaching double figures scoring in all three of the Bucs' games in Canada.

Big South Regular Season Championships in 2013 & 2015 (NIT both years)

Barclay Radebaugh has presided over one of the most successful stretches in Charleston Southern history during his 11 years as head coach. Radebaugh is the winningest coach in school history, the 5th winningest coach in Big South Conference history, and is one of only eight coaches to win multiple Big South Coach of the Year awards. He has directed CSU to Big South regular season championships and NIT berths in 2012-13 and 2014-15.

Radebaugh has established CSU as a perennial Big South contender thanks in part to its ability to protect the Buc Dome. CSU went 13-2 at home in 2014-15, improving its mark in the building over that six-year stretch to 67-18 overall, and 39-13 in Big South play.

Radebaugh led CSU to a 19-10 regular season record in 2014-15, including a 13-5 Big South Conference finish. The 19 overall wins, and 13 leagues victories, are both regular season program records. CSU captured its second Big South regular season title in the last three years and advanced to the National Invitation Tournament. The Bucs made the most of the experience just as they did in 2013, leading Old Dominion by six points at halftime before falling to the top-seeded Monarchs.

Radebaugh piloted CSU to an overtime win at Ole Miss to start the season, as the Bucs knocked off a power conference opponent for the second time in school history. CSU put together a pair of five-game winning streaks in conference play to win a Big South title for the second time in three years. The Bucs had not won a regular season championship in the 26 years prior, and had advanced to postseason play just once in the program's previous 47 seasons.

Saah Nimley capped off a brilliant playing career under Radebaugh's guidance by capturing Big South Player of the Year accolades. He was also named an Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American, making him the first player in program history to receive the honor. Only 63 players in the entire country were recognized by the AP. Nimley finished the year ranked 5th nationally in scoring and three-pointers per game, had 17 20-point games, seven 30-point games, and was the only player in the country to record four consecutive 30-point efforts.

Will Saunders garnered 2nd Team All-Conference accolades under Radebaugh's tutelage, while Arlon Harper was named Honorable Mention All-Conference. CSU led the Big South in conference games in five different statistical categories. The Bucs continued to excel as one of the nation's most explosive offensive clubs and ranked 11th in threes per game and 33rd in scoring offense. CSU also ranked among the nation's best in offensive rebounds per game (20th), total rebounds per game (49th) and turnover margin.

CSU won a game in the Big South Conference Tournament for the third consecutive year in 2013-14, rallying from a 15-point first half deficit to defeat Campbell before falling to eventual league champion Coastal Carolina on its home floor in double overtime. The Bucs again proved to be prolific offensively under Radebaugh's leadership, finishing the season third nation-

ally in threes per game and 10th in scoring. CSU enjoyed victories over two teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament, defeating CAA champion Delaware on the road in November, and also routing Coastal at home.

CSU entered the 2012-13 season as the Big South favorite and backed up that billing with a 12-4 conference record which earned the Bucs the inaugural South Division championship, as well as the de facto league-wide regular season crown. Led by the sophomore backcourt of Saah Nimley (All-Big South 1st Team) and Arlon Harper (All-Big South 2nd Team), CSU highlighted its first regular-season conference title in 26 years with an eight-game winning streak that was the third longest in school history and included a 7-0 start to Big South play.

The Bucs also reached their first Big South Tournament title game since 2005 with a pair of tough wins over Winthrop and VMI. CSU fell to a red-hot Liberty team in the final to miss out on a trip to the NCAA Tournament, but reached national postseason play for just the second time in school history with a berth in the NIT. Radebaugh and a still young squad made the most of the experience, giving top-seeded Southern Miss all it could handle in a 78-71 loss before a raucous partisan crowd in Hattiesburg.

Under Radebaugh's guidance, CSU once again thrived offensively in 2012-13, as it finished the year 39th nationally in scoring offense. The three-point shot continued to be a strength for the Bucs, who led the country in made threes per game for parts of the year and finished second behind only Iowa State.

Radebaugh earned Big South Conference Coach of the Year honors for his efforts in 2011-12, as the Bucs went 19-12 and advanced to the conference tournament semifinals behind a starting lineup which featured three freshmen and a junior college transfer. CSU's 19 wins were the program's most since 1994-1995, as the Bucs secured their first winning season since 1996-1997. Senior Kelvin

Martin led the way for Radebaugh's young group, as the forward played his way onto the all-conference first team while earning a nod as the league's defensive player of the year for a second consecutive season. The freshmen duo of Saah Nimley and Arlon Harper helped power a CSU offense which featured outstanding balance and had four players in double figures for the majority of the season (Martin, Nimley, Harper, and Mathiang Muo). As a team, CSU finished the season 22nd nationally in scoring (76.9 ppg), 20th in three-point field goals per game (8.4), 30th in three-point field goal percentage (38.0%), 40th in steals per game (8.1) and 27th in turnover margin (+2.7).

The Bucs opened the season in style when they led Big 12 power Kansas State by 14 at halftime, before taking the Wildcats all the way to the wire in a 72-67 loss. Radebaugh's squad also enjoyed a home-and-away sweep of Atlantic Sun foe Stetson, a 33-point home victory over VMI, an 18-point blowout of then first-place Campbell, a triumph at Big South regular season and tournament champion and previously undefeated UNC Asheville, and a conference tournament win over Liberty.

CSU took a step forward in 2010-2011 as well, as it went 16-16 overall and 9-9 in the Big South, finishing sixth in the conference. The Bucs went 12-3 at home, highlighted by a second straight win over The Citadel, and conference victories over the likes of rivals Winthrop and UNC Asheville.

In his first season at CSU, Radebaugh put his imprint on the program immediately by leading the Bucs to a 13-16 overall record and an appearance in the Big South Tournament Semifinals. The Buccaneers also beat the College of Charleston for the first time since 1988, and captured the city championship for the first time since 1986 with a victory over The Citadel.

The Bucs followed this performance with a second consecutive city championship in 2006. Big home victories over High Point, Liberty and Coastal Carolina highlighted his third season at the helm. The Buccaneers also set a Big South record with 10 Freshman of the Week honors, capped off by Omar Carter earning Big South Freshman of the Year.

Radebaugh has an impressive coaching resume from a career that began in 1986 as a student assistant coach at East Tennessee State under Les Robinson. After stops at Wofford and Furman, Radebaugh began a seven-year stay at South Carolina.

While at South Carolina, the Gamecocks won the SEC regular season title and received a number two seed in the 1997 NCAA tournament. In 1998, the Gamecocks finished the season ranked 14th and received a number three seed in the NCAA tournament. At South Carolina, Radebaugh was the position coach for USC's all-time leading scorer B.J. McKie, all-time three-point scorer Jamel Bradley, and all-time steals leader Chuck Eidson, the cousin of former Buccaneer Director of Operations Sean Sweeney.

Radebaugh continued his success as an assistant at Winthrop University, helping the Eagles to back-to-back Big South Conference titles and an NCAA tournament berth in 2002.

Radebaugh then spent one season as the head coach at Queens University in Charlotte, guiding the Royals to a 21-8 record overall and a 14-4 record in the Carolinas-Virginia Athletic Conference. There, Radebaugh coached Spencer Ross who was named the Sporting News Division II National Player of the Year. Spencer was the only Division II player in the country invited to the Plymouth, Va. NBA pre-draft camp.

A native of Lincolnton, North Carolina, Radebaugh received his master of arts degree in physical education from the University of South Carolina in 1996 and earned his bachelor of science degree in business administration at East Tennessee State in 1987.

Radebaugh and his wife, Hope, have three children: Anna (25), Reid (20) and Sophia (17).

Former University of South Carolina standout BJ McKie has impacted one of the most successful stretches in Charleston Southern history in his five years on the bench. He has teamed with Radebaugh, an assistant at South Carolina when McKie played for the Gamecocks from 1996-99, to help lead CSU to two Big South regular season championships and a pair of NIT berths.

McKie was promoted to the role of Associate Head Coach in August of 2015. During the 2015-16 season, McKie aided the maturation of Armel Potter, who earned All-Big South Freshman Team honors and emerged as one of the top guards in the conference.

McKie was part of a staff that piloted the Bucs to the winningest regular season in school history in 2014-15. CSU won the Big South regular season title after being picked to finish 5th in the preseason poll. McKie continued to work closely with CSU's guards, and seniors Saah Nimley and Arlon Harper cemented their place as elite players in program history under his watch. Nimley earned Big South Player of the Year honors and finished the season ranked 5th nationally in both scoring and three-pointers per game. Harper earned Honorable Mention All-Conference accolades, finished third in the Big South in steals and capped his career 8th in league annals in steals. The duo ranks as the third highest scoring four-year classmate combinatino in Big South history.

CSU's backcourt powered the nation's tenth best scoring offense in 2013-14. The three-point shot propelled the Bucs, as they finished third in the country in made threes per game.

Guard play was once again the Bucs' strength in 2012-13, as McKie helped tutor a group led by All-Big South selections Nimley (1st Team) and Harper (2nd Team). The duo avoided a sophomore slump by combining to average over 31 points a game while placing themselves among the conference's leaders in assists, steals, three-point shooting, and several other statistical categories. Depth in the backcourt was also a strength for CSU, as senior Jeremy Sexton capped off his career as the Bucs' 7th all-time leading scorer thanks to a senior year which saw him drill 52 three-pointers at a 36 percent clip. Juniors Sheldon Strickland and Matt Kennedy also provided a lift off the bench at some key junctures.

McKie was instrumental in the growth of Nimley and Harper as freshmen in 2011-12, as the duo started a combined 56 games and helped power a CSU offense which finished the season 22nd in scoring, 20th in three-point field goals per game, and 30th in three-point field goal percentage. For their individual efforts, Nimley and Harper were each named to the Big South All-Freshman Team. The Bucs also received strong efforts from junior Jeremy Sexton and sophomore Sheldon Strickland.

McKie joined the coaching ranks after completing a professional playing career in Europe, and is now reunited with Radebaugh, who served as an assistant coach during McKie's time at USC.

"BJ is a tremendous addition to our basketball staff," Radebaugh said at the time of McKie's hiring. "I have known BJ for over a decade and have great respect for him as a person and an excitement for what he will bring to our program as an assistant coach. His work ethic, tenacity and understanding of how to play the game were unmatched as a player. I know our players will benefit greatly from his collegiate and professional experiences."

A native of Norfolk, Va., McKie finished his playing career at South Carolina (1996-99) as the Gamecocks' all-time leading scorer with 2,119 career points and was honored by the Southeast Conference as an SEC Basketball Legend as part of its class of 2011. McKie was named the 1996 SEC Freshman of the Year, and is just the 12th player in league history to earn Associated Press First Team SEC honors for three seasons. The two-time team captain played in 123 consecutive games at the guard position, scoring in double figures 111 times and recording 38 games with 20 or more points. McKie averaged 17.3 points per game as senior and finished third in SEC scoring that season. In 1997, McKie averaged 17.4 ppg to lead the Gamecocks to their first ever SEC basketball title. South Carolina appeared in the NCAA Tournament in both 1997 and 1998, ranking 14th in the nation and receiving the number three seed in the 1998 NCAA Tournament. He is one of five Gamecock players to have his jersey retired.

Following his career at USC, McKie competed professionally for a number of teams overseas. McKie played for BCM Gravelines in France, Keravnos in Cyprus, as well as Avitos Geissen and TBB Trier in Germany. He also spent time with Pepsi Caserta and Nuova Pallacanestro Pavia in Italy; Maccabi Haifa Heat and Hapoel Afula in Israel. In 2004, McKie was named a Basketball Bundesliga (Player of the Year) while competing in Germany. He was also a 2001 CBA All-Star while playing for the Connecticut Pride of the Continental Basketball Association.

McKie is married to the former Brittany Brooks. He has one son, Justin, currently a student and men's basketball player at South Carolina.

Ahmad Smith has been an integral part of one of the best stretches in Charleston Southern history during his five years under head coach Barclay Radebaugh. Smith returned to college coaching after spending three years in several capacities, including that of head coach, in Ireland.

Smith was promoted to the role of Assistant Head Coach/Recruiting Coordinator in August of 2015.

CSU won its second Big South regular season title in three years in 2014-15, and advanced to the NIT. The Bucs put together the winningest regular season in the program's 50-year history thanks in part to its ability to rebound the basketball. CSU ranked 2nd in the Big South in both rebounding margin and offensive rebounds, and was 20th nationally in the latter category. As posts coach, Smith helped lead a CSU team that led the Big South in offensive rebounding for much of the year. Paul Gombwer and Will Saunders each ranked top-ten in the conference in rebounding, while Gombwer, Cedrick Bowen and Aaron Wheeler were all among the top-ten in offensive rebounds.

Under Smith's tutelage, Gombwer and Bowen capped off terrific four-year playing careers for the Bucs. Gombwer rose to 5th in CSU history, and 17th in Big South annals, in career rebounds. Bowen enjoyed the best season of his career, averaging over eight points and four rebounds per game. Bowen ranked 6th in the Big South in offensive rebounds and shot over 60 percent from the floor en route to keeping his place as the second leading field goal percentage shooter in CSU history.

CSU again ranked among the Big South's best rebounding teams in 2013-14, tallying a nearly +3.0 margin on the glass. Gombwer led the way with better than 6.5 rebounds per game and again finished among the Big South's top-ten in offensive rebounds.

A former player and coach at Appalachian State, Smith helped CSU get more production from its post players in 2012-13. Bowen, in particular, showed marked improvement from his freshman season. Bowen averaged 7.5 points a game while shooting over 57 percent from the floor, pulled down four rebounds a night and upped his free-throw percentage by 29 points (50 to 79). Gombwer continued to be a force on the glass, placing 11th in the Big South in rebounding and 8th in offensive boards. Junior college transfer Allie Fullah experienced some growing pains but proved to be a factor around the rim, ranking 3rd in the conference in blocked shots with 43 to give the Bucs a presence in the paint defensively.

Smith helped foster the growth of Bowen and Gombwer as freshmen in 2011-2012, as CSU went 19-12 and won its first Big South Tournament game since 2006. Bowen started the first 22 games of the season for the Bucs at center, while Gombwer started the final nine and was a force on the offensive glass, ranking 12th in the Big South with 79 for the year (better than 2.5 per game). The duo also provided some inside scoring punch as well to help CSU to a 19-win season for the first time since 1994-1995.

"I am so appreciative to Coach Radebaugh for giving me this opportunity," said Smith at the time of his hiring in the summer of 2011. "It is great to be a part of the program and join this coaching staff. This is a great opportunity to further my coaching career."

Smith came to CSU from Dublin, Ireland, where he honed his coaching skills from 2008 on. Most recently, Smith served as the technical director for the Templeogue Basketball Club. He was also the head basketball coach for the Men's Division I, U17 and U18 teams. In 2011, the Division I men's team finished fifth, improving five spots from the year before Smith's arrival.

Prior to that, Smith was the head men's and women's basketball coach at Institute of Technology Tallaght College in Dublin, finished as the 2011 women's team champions and the 2011 men's team runners-up. He holds a career 74-45 record as a head coach, including time with the Colaiste Eanna High School U19 Boys (2009-2011), and the Shamrock Rovers Hoops Professional Superleague, where he coached from August 2008 to March 2010.

Before leaving for Ireland, Smith was an assistant coach at Appalachian State University from 2004-08, helping lead the Mountaineers to a school-record 25 wins in 2006-07, a North Division regular season SoCon Championship in 2008 and a San Juan Shootout Tournament championship in 2007.

As a player, Smith spent two years at Cedar Valley Junior College, earning NJCAA All-American honors while leading his team to an NJCAA National Championship in 2001. He earned the school's student-athlete award and earned multiple conference honors, including all-conference and freshman of the year honors, before moving on to play two years for the Mountaineers in the Southern Conference.

He and his wife, Teresa, have a son, Tristan (4 years old).

Joey Murdock enters his second season on head coach Barclay Radebaugh's staff in 2016-17. Murdock has been integral as a driving force in the Bucs' recruiting efforts as the program seeks to return to the form that paved the way for 2013 and 2015 Big South Conference regular season championships.

Murdock, a former graduate assistant under Jeff Lebo at Auburn, came to CSU after spending five years as an assistant coach at Pensacola State College.

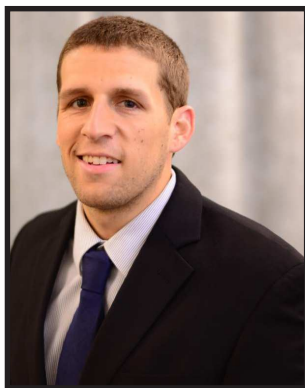
Murdock helped direct Pensacola State to the 2013-14 Panhandle Conference championship, marking the program's first league title since 1997. Pensacola State advanced to the Florida State Junior College Tournament that season and in 2014-15, giving the program back-to-back regional tournament appearances for the first time in 22 years. Last season, Pensacola finished second in the Panhandle Conference behind only eventual NJCAA national champion, Northwest Florida.

Murdock's recruiting prowess was pivotal in Pensacola's success. He recruited 21 players that graduated and moved on to play at the Division I level, including several at the high-major level.

A 2005 graduate of the University of West Florida, Murdock got his start in coaching as a student manager at Pensacola State in 2001. He spent three seasons as the head coach at Tate High School in Pensacola before moving on to a graduate assistant spot at Auburn in 2009.

Murdock is a native of Toledo, Ohio, and is married to the former Lori Eckhard of Miami, Fla.

Thomas Butters enters his third season on the Charleston Southern coaching staff in 2016-17. Butters joined CSU as video coordinator in September 2014.
