HEAD COACH: KATHY RILEY

Coach Riley is in her 20th year as a head coach at Longwood University, beginning in 1998. 2015 Big South Coach of the Year. A Collegiate All-American in both softball and basketball. She has a special ability to get the most out of the athletes, showing them that the sky is the limit. Her years of experience at the game begins an advantage to those who work with her. CAMP DIRECTOR: KAYLA MILLER

Coach Kayla is in her 17th year as the assistant coach at Longwood. She is the pitching coach for the Lancers along with responsibilities such as: budget, recruiting, camp and team travel.

Megan Baltzell

Former Longwood All-American catcher and two-time Big South Player of the Year Megan Baltzell has joined the Lancer coaching staff as a volunteer assistant coach. Baltzell works primarily with the catchers and assist with hitting instruction. The 2014 and 2015 Big South Player of the Year and the 2015 Big South Female Athlete of the Year, Baltzell finished among the top-10 all-time in NCAA history with 76 career home runs, ranking among the top-three in the nation in 2013 (30) and 2015 (27). In addition, Baltzell competed on the United States Women's National Team and participated at the WBSC Women's Baseball World Cup in September.



Emily Murphy

Former Longwood shortstop and four-time All-Big South selection Emily Murphy has joined the Lancer softball coaching staff as an assistant coach. Murphy works primarily with the middle infielders and assist with hitting instruction. A 2016 graduate of Longwood, Murphy led the blue and white to three Big South Championships to go along with two regular season crowns and three appearances in the NCAA Tournament. Murphy helped Longwood win three games in the NCAA Tournament throughout her career, including victories over ACC foes North Carolina and Virginia Tech. Murphy is one of 17 players in Big South history to earn all-conference honors in each of her four seasons.
