THE OPENING TIP

- Longwood looks to win its second straight game inside Willett Hall Sunday, as the Lancers play host to Northeast Conference foe Fairleigh Dickinson.
- The Lancers have a pair of double figure scorers in Kristina Antonenko and Autumn Childress. Antonenko ranks second in the Big South with 18.0 points per game while Childress is among the best in the conference with 13.7 points and 9.0 rebounds, both among the top 10 in the league.
- Micaela Ellis enters Sunday's game 34 assists shy of entering the top 10 all-time in the program's history in career assists and sits just 89 assists away from breaking Crystal Smith's Division I record. The assists record comes on the heels of a season in which she placed top-five all-time in single season assists.

LAST TIME OUT

- Paced by a dominant 19 point, 15 rebound performance from senior Autumn Childress that led a barrage of five Lancers in double figures, the Longwood women's basketball team picked up its first win of the season in 84-82 fashion over UMass Lowell in the squad's 2017-18 home opener Saturday afternoon inside Willett Hall.
- Childress had 13 of her 19 points in the second half to lead the charge for a Longwood (1-2) squad that saw nine of 10 players that played find the scoring column and open a 19-point advantage with less than a minute to play in the first half.
- Stephanie Guihon's 17-point effort against UMass Lowell marked the most points by a freshman in their Willett Hall debut in the D-I era, bettering the 14 points totaled by current sophomore Jada Russell in last season's home opener against West Virginia Tech.

BY THE NUMBERS

- The Lancers are in their 11th season in the Division I era and sixth season as a full member of the Big South Conference.
- Longwood welcomes nine newcomers for the 2017-18 season -- the most within the Big South Conference
- Longwood is in its eighth season under the guidance of head coach Bill Reinson. In 2013, Reinson led the Lancers to the Big South Championship game falling to Liberty.
- Longwood athletics has partnered with regional telecommunications company Shentel to air all home basketball games on a dedicated Shentel channel, extending the Lancers' broadcast footprint to the company's coverage areas in Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia and West Virginia. Shentel subscribers can watch Longwood men's and women's basketball's Big South Network broadcasts on channel 81.
- Longwood will take part in four Education Day's this season with two coming at home and two on the road. The four Education Days are tied for the most in the conference with Gardner-Webb, as seven of the 10 schools in the conference will play at least one Education Day.
- Junior college transfer Kristina Antonenko matched Longwood's Division I record for most points in a single game with 33 points in Longwood's loss at N.C. Central Tuesday. The 33 points is the most by any player in the Big South in the early portion of the season.

- Fairleigh Dickinson comes to Farmville for the first time in the program's history, as the Lancers look to avenge last year's loss against the Knights.

SCOUTING THE KNIGHTS

- Fairleigh Dickinson comes to Farmville winners in four of its five games to open the season with the Knights winning their last game prior to the Thanksgiving holiday 61-51 over Colgate.
- The Knights have three players averaging in double figures with Amina Markovic leading the way with 13.5 points per game. In addition, Lauren Francillion (12.0) and Natalie Zamora (10.3) are also averaging in double figures.
- As a team, Fairleigh Dickinson is shooting a red-hot .442 from the field and a .316 mark from beyond the arc.
- In its last game Wednesday against Colgate, the Knights started the game just 3-of-18 from the floor throughout the first quarter. However, FDU was able to turn it around and finished the game with nearly a .400 shooting clip from the floor including a scorching 7-of-15 (.467) mark from three-point range.
- Fairleigh Dickinson was tabbed to finish seventh in the Northeast Conference preseason poll after finishing 6-12 in the league a season ago. Amina Markovic also earned a spot on the Preseason All-NEC Team.

ANTONENKO'S RECORD-SETTING DAY

- Junior college transfer Kristina Antonenko enjoyed a record-setting day in Tuesday's game against N.C. Central, as the junior poured in 33 points on 14-of-20 field goals.
- Antonenko's performance against the Eagles matched the 33 points that Becky Fernandes finished with during the 2009 season against NJIT, tying Longwood's Division I single game scoring record. In addition, it was the first time a Lancer had hit the 30-point plateau since Crystal Smith scored 32 against Campbell in Longwood's debut season in the Big South in 2012-13.
- The 33-point outburst from the Moscow, Russia product marks the most from any Lancer in the Big South era, as she becomes the league's first player this season to finish a game with 30-plus.
- In the early portion of the season, Antonenko ranks second among players in the Big South with 21.0 points per game and is one of three players in the conference to average 20 or more. She also ranks second in the conference with a .643 field-goal percentage.

- With the ball, the Lancers will look to push the pace and ample opportunities to get easy buckets. In addition, the Lancers will look for more opportunities to shoot the three-point shot as well.
- Defensively, the Lancers will look to press and trap the opposition, looking to cause turnovers to get out in transition for easy buckets.

- Micaela Ellis is on pace to break Longwood's Division I assists record during her senior season. Ellis enters Saturday's game 94 assists shy of breaking Crystal Smith's Division I record of 356 career assists.

- Micaela Ellis joined Longwood's all-time top 10 in single season assists the final Monday of the 2016-17 regular season at High Point. Ellis, who owns Longwood's Division I assist single season and single game assists record, finished last season tied fifth on Longwood's single season assists charts.
- Ellis recorded at least three assists in 21 of Longwood's last 22 games of the 2016-17 season with a combined 25 coming in the season series against Winthrop. Ellis passed Crystal Smith and her 111 assists during the 2011-12 season to set Longwood's Division I record.
- For her career, Ellis has 249 career assists and will enter her senior season with a chance to break Longwood's Division I career assist record, currently held by Crystal Smith with 356 while moving into the top 10 all-time in program history

STAFF CHANGES

- Longwood has made a number of changes to its coaching staff for the 2017-18 season. Antwon Harris and Messiah Reames both joined the staff over the summer while Sherrie Tucker was elevated from assistant coach to associate head coach entering her fifth season with the team.
- Harris, a two-time Big South champion at Winthrop, comes to Longwood after spending last season as the head women's basketball coach at Highland Community College in Freeport, Ill., where he previously served as assistant coach for two seasons before being promoted to head coach.
- Reames, a three-time all-conference selection, comes to Longwood after spending time coaching at the high school level, the Philly Triple Threat AAU program and working as a skills assistant with James Madison and George Washington.
- Elevated to associate head coach, Tucker enters her fifth season on the women's basketball coaching staff. She has been involved in all aspects of the program since her arrival to campus.

LANCERS PICKED NINTH IN PRESEASON

- Longwood was tabbed ninth in the Big South among the Big South coaches at the conference's media day.
- 2017-18 marks the second straight season the Lancers have been tabbed ninth in the Big South Coaches Preseason Poll. Last season, the Lancers finished 10th in the league.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

- Junior guard Micaela Ellis is Longwood's lone captain for the 2017-18 season. It marks her third straight campaign serving in a captaincy role after being named captain as a sophomore and junior.

EIGHTH SEASON UNDER REINSON

- Longwood is in its eighth season under head coach Bill Reinson.
- The 2013 Richmond Times Dispatch Virginia Women's Basketball Coach of the Year, Reinson aided the development in Longwood's three Division I 1,000-point scorers -- Chelsea Coward, Crystal Smith and Daeisha Brown.
- Reinson led Longwood to the 2013 Big South Championship game in the program's first season in the league before falling to Liberty.

LONGWOOD BASKETBALL ON SHENTEL

- Longwood athletics has partnered with regional telecommunications company Shentel to air all home basketball games on a dedicated Shentel channel, extending the Lancers' broadcast footprint to the company's coverage areas in Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia and West Virginia.
- Shentel subscribers can watch Longwood men's and women's basketball's Big South Network broadcasts on channel 81. The games will be simulcasts of the Big South Network production, which provides live, high-definition coverage of more than 50 Longwood athletics contests each year.
- The partnership with Shentel is in addition to Longwood's existing broadcast options on the Big South Network and Farmville radio station WVHL 92.9 Kickin' Country FM.

WELCOME TO LONGWOOD

- Longwood head women's basketball coach Bill Reinson announced the addition of nine newcomers for the 2017-18 season. Those newcomers include transfers Rosemary Ilang, Kristina Antonenko and Elena Flowers, along with freshmen Que King, Stephanie Guihon, Jessica Belcher, Mallory Odell and Malasia Boyd. In addition, former club basketball member Casey Ripp joined the squad.
- A product of Stone Mountain, Ga., Belcher becomes the first player to call the Peach State home to sign with the Lancers in the Division I era. Averaging in double figures the past two seasons, Belcher tallied 12.9 points, 4.5 assists and 3.2 rebounds last season as a junior.
- Guihon, a 5-7 guard from Largo, Md., was a four-year standout at Largo High School, where she tallied 1,363 points throughout her illustrious high school career that was capped by her being named 2017 Prince George's Sentinel All-County Female Player of the Year.
- Ilang joined the program as a junior on the Lancer roster after enjoying success at the junior college level the last two seasons with Binn College as a freshman and Western Texas Community College as a sophomore.
- King adds depth to the Lancer backcourt after she was a three-year starter at William Fleming High School. King led William Fleming to four district championships and three regional championships, and was named all-district in each of her three years of starting.
- Odell comes to Longwood as a dual-sport athlete in basketball and softball. A finalist for the United States U-16 National team in 2015, Odell will come to Longwood as a 1,000-point scorer and owner of the Deep Run school record for most double-doubles in a season with 13.
- In addition, Antonenko, Flowers and Ripp all joined the squad as a walk-on prior to preseason training.

Bill Reinson begins his 16th season in the athletics department at Longwood and eighth season as the leader of the women's basketball program. Throughout his tenure, Reinson has guided the Lancers to a 52-156 mark since taking over as interim head coach on Dec. 6, 2010. He was officially elevated to the head coaching position following the 2010-11 season on April 12, 2011.

Throughout his seven-year tenure, Reinson has guided the Lancer program into the Big South era. His 2012-13 team advanced to the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Championship game before falling to Liberty. He was named the 2013 Virginia Women's Basketball Coach of the Year by the Richmond Times-Dispatch. In addition, Reinson has coached the program's only three 1,000-point scorers in the Division I era, including Daeisha Brown, Chelsea Coward and Crystal Smith.

During his tenure, Longwood has tested itself against many of the top programs in the nation, playing the likes of Duke, Notre Dame, Maryland and Oregon State. The Lancers have played four games against ranked competition, with three games against teams inside the top-10.

The 2016-17 campaign saw Reinson guide Longwood to a 4-26 overall record and a 1-17 mark in the Big South. Reinson saw the development of Eboni Gilliam, who averaged a team-leading 10.4 points per game. In addition, Reinson helped in the development of Micaela Ellis, who finished the season with 133 assists for most assists in the school's D-I era. Ellis also finished with a school-record 15 assists in Longwood's win against Winthrop.

The 2015-16 season saw Reinson guide the Lancers to an 8-22 overall record and a 5-15 mark in the Big South, as injuries plagued the roster throughout the season with just three players on the 16-man roster having played in each of the team's 30 games. Reinson oversaw the development of Longwood's roster, in particular, Micaela Ellis who led the team in assists and minutes. Longwood was led in scoring by senior Kyn-dal Skersick and redshirt-junior Brown, who each averaged 9.0 points per game. In addition, junior college transfer Eboni Gilliam provided a rebounding and low-post threat for the Lancers, leading the team and ranking among the top-10 in the Big South with 6.9 boards per contest.

In addition, Brown became the 21st player in program history and the third player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 career points in a Longwood uniform Feb. 20, 2016 at Radford. Brown became the fastest player in the Division I era to reach 1,000 points, doing so in

her 80th career game, five games faster than it took Coward to reach the milestone.

The 2014-15 campaign saw Reinson lead Longwood to a 4-26 overall record. Injuries plagued the Longwood roster throughout the campaign, with ACL tears to Brown, a Preseason Second-Team All-Big South selection and leading rebounder Khlaliah Ali. Reinson oversaw the development of Raven Williams who elevated her level of play despite the injury to Brown, averaging 13.3 points per contest to earn Honorable Mention All-Big South honors.

Perhaps, Reinson's biggest regular season victory came during the 2013-14 season where the Lancers downed Xavier, 67-64. It was the highlight of the season for a Longwood squad that posted an 8-22 overall record, including a mark of 5-15 in Big South competition. The Lancers were led by backcourt duo of Brown and Williams, who each averaged in double figures.

In 2012-13, Reinson guided his squad to a 14-19 over-

all record, including an 8-10 mark in the program's inaugural season in the Big South, and an appearance in the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Championship game. The Lancers' 14 wins marked the most victories for the team since its first year playing a Division I schedule back in 2007-08 (16). Under Reinson's guidance, the Lancers won their first four games of the Big South era, including its Big South debut at Gardner-Webb.

The team earned the No. 7 seed for the tournament before winning three-straight postseason games to advance to the conference's title game against in-state foe Liberty University. Longwood's run to the Championship marked just the third time in Big South history that a No. 7 seed played in the championship game. For his efforts, Reinson was recognized as the 2013 Virginia Women's Basketball Coach of the Year by the Richmond Times-Dispatch.

Reinson's first full season in leading the blue and white saw the Lancers finish with a 7-22 mark. The Lancers played two games against top-15 opponents, including a narrow 56-45 defeat at No. 11 Georgetown in the season-opener. Longwood also faced national-power Maryland. The Lancers had three double figure scorers throughout the season, including Smith (11.2 PPG), Brittani Billups (11.0 PPG) and Coward (10.3 PPG).

After taking over the program six games into the 2011-12 season and being elevated to interim head coach from men's assistant coach, Reinson guided the Lancers to six of their seven victories throughout the season. Following a 1-5 start to the season, Reinson took the reins of the program and earned his first victory of his tenure with a 74-70 decision against Wright State.

Prior to taking over the women's program, Reinson had been an assistant coach with the Longwood men's program since 2002. He served as the interim men's head coach for two games (1-1) late in the 2002-03 season, his first at the school, due to an illness of the head coach at that time.

Additionally, he was an assistant women's coach with the Lancers for the final 13 games of 2002-03 (27-5) under Longwood's all-time winningest coach and 2015 Longwood Hall of Fame inductee Shirley Duncan during the final year of Division II eligibility, helping the team to an 11-2 record in those games while winning the CVAC Tournament and advancing to the second-round of the NCAA East Regional.

His first position in the coaching ranks saw Reinson serve two seasons (2000-02) as an assistant men's coach at UNC Greensboro. During his time at UNCG, Reinson learned under the tutelage of current Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery. The Spartans went 39-23 overall throughout his two seasons, winning the 2001 Southern Conference Tournament Championship. UNC Greensboro earned one NCAA Tournament appearance (2001) and made one NIT appearance (2002).

A native of Mesa, Arizona, Reinson earned his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Phoenix. He and his wife, Lana, have seven daughters: Megan (28), a graduate of Virginia Tech, Bria (23), Taylor (19), twins Ashley (14) and Brittany (14), Krystal (13), and Mia (9) along with three sons: Dominic (16), Niko (15) and Spiros (13).

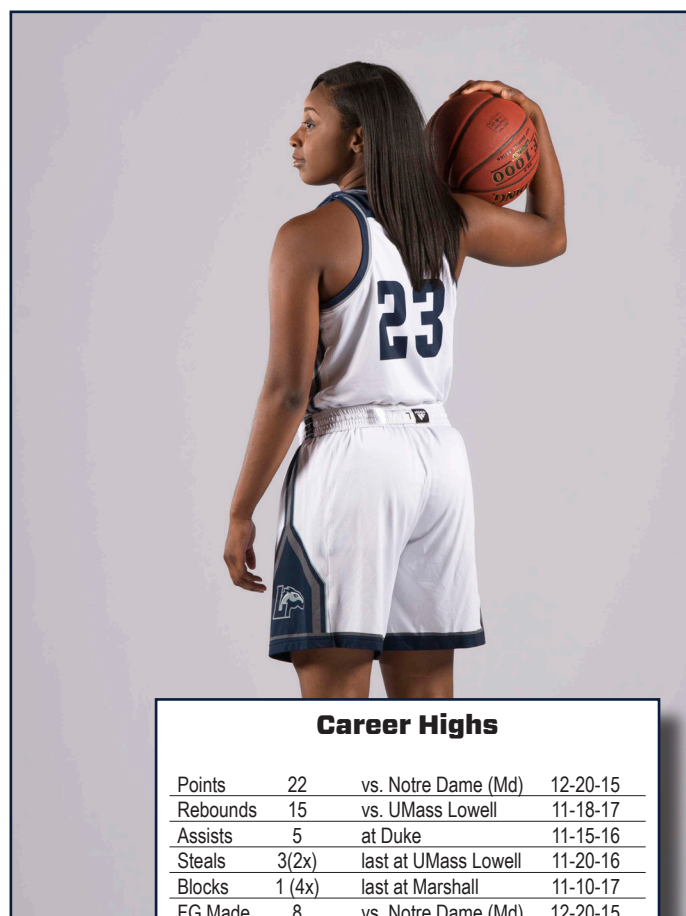
