

## LONGWOOD BLASTS RANDOLPH-MACON 24-10

The Longwood College baseball team took a decisive 24-10 triumph at Randolph-Macon Wednesday, the highest run production of the spring for the Lancers. Coach Buddy Bolding's squad is now 26-7 overall, remaining 16-5 in the CVAC -- ranked 30th in this week's COLLEGIATE BASEBALL DIVISION II COACHES POLL.

At Macon, LC scored seven runs during both the third and fifth innings en route to the lopsided victory. The Lancers got home runs in the contest from sophomores **Anthony Pennix/William Campbell HS** (5th inning, two-on) and **Doug Kenney/Cave Spring HS** (8th inning, one-on), along with freshman **David Robinson/Midlothian HS** (8th inning, one-on). Pennix finished 3-6 with three runs and three RBI, Kenney was 4-6 with four runs and five RBI, and Robinson finished 2-4 with two runs and three RBI. Additionally, junior captain **Shawn Torian/Halifax County HS** was 5-6 with four runs and five RBI -- clubbing two doubles. Pennix (4-0) earned the mound win, pitching the final 7.2 innings in relief while scattering 11 hits with seven strikeouts.

### EDMONDS CVAC PITCHER OF WEEK

Junior captain **Greg Edmonds/Midlothian HS** was selected as the **CVAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK** following his outstanding effort against 25-ranked Coker (S.C.) April 11 and April 13. The left-handed hurler tossed a complete-game, four-hit shutout with five strikeouts as LC took a 7-0 victory over the Cobras April 11. Edmonds then pitched the final 2.1 innings of relief against Coker during Longwood's 9-7 triumph April 13 to earn his second win over the nationally-ranked squad in two games. For the season, Edmonds is 5-0 on the mound with a team-best 3.38 ERA through 40.0 innings with 37 strikeouts.

### SEASON STATISTICAL LEADERS

Through 33 games, Torian (.486, 12 HR, 44 RBI) continues to lead Longwood - and the CVAC - offensively as the third-year right fielder is enjoying an outstanding campaign. Torian is followed by freshman **Travis Pfitzner/Gar-Field HS** (.385, 4 HR, 29 RBI), Kenney (.364, 3 HR, 29 RBI), junior captain **Fred Stoots/Clover Hill HS** (.362, 9 HR, 38 RBI), Pennix (.336, 9 HR, 32 RBI), and freshman **Ryan Costa/Buffalo Gap HS** (.300, 2 HR, 19 RBI). The mound efforts are being led by Edmonds (5-0, 3.38 ERA, 40.0 innings, 37 K), followed by junior **Robey Caldwell/Cave Spring HS** (3-2, 3.82 ERA, 37.2 innings, 44 K), and freshman **Mike Sullivan/Gar-Field HS** (4-3, 4.06 ERA, 51.0 innings, 48 K). The Lancers continue to hit for average at .332 as a team with 54 home runs and 293 RBI. LC's pitching staff has a 4.87 ERA through 260.2 innings with 251 strikeouts.

### CVAC TOURNAMENT 1ST-ROUND AT LANCER STADIUM

#2 seed Longwood and #7 seed Belmont Abbey (N.C.) are scheduled to play two games Saturday, April 18, beginning at noon, with a third game Sunday, April 19, at 1 p.m., if necessary. A pair of wins over the weekend would advance the nationally-ranked Lancers to Wilson, N.C. for the **CVAC BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP**, a four-team, double-elimination tournament at Barton (N.C.) next weekend, April 24-26.
