### LEADING OFF

- Longwood closes its 10-game homestand with a crucial Big South series against first-place and rival Liberty, with Sunday's game being nationally broadcasted on ESPNU.
- Longwood is playing its best softball of the season to date. The Lancers have won 13 of their last 16 and are in second-place in the Big South standings -- just two games back of Liberty.
- Sophomore **Kasey Carr** has been on a tear of late. She's collected hits in 14 of her last 19 games and in Friday's win over Campbell drove in a career-best three RBI.
- Despite playing top opponents across the country, Longwood has four players batting above the .300 mark after not having a single player bat above .300 a season ago. **Kaylynn Batten** leads the way with a .344, while, **Jessica Smith** (.326), **Kasey Carr** (.308) and **Krista Kelly** (.301) are all batting above .300.

## BY THE NUMBERS

- A season after winning its fourth Big South championship in a five year span, Longwood looks to four-peat as the conference tournament champions in 2018.
- Longwood's non-conference opponents combined for more than 550 wins a season ago with 12 of those teams finishing with a record of .500 or better. In addition, the Lancers will play six games against five different teams that made the 2017 NCAA Tournament.
- For the third straight season, Longwood was tabbed to win the Big South. Despite capturing four Big South Championships in its five previous seasons, the Lancers have only been tabbed to win the conference in each of the last three seasons.
- Longwood returns six players that have earned Big South accolades throughout their career, including **Kaylynn Batten, Karleigh Donovan, Sydney Gay, Krista Kelly, Kelsey Sweeney** and **Glenn Walters**.
- Longwood softball head coach Kathy Riley enters her 21st season leading the program. Longwood's all-time winningest coach, Riley has amassed more than 600 wins at Longwood and picked up her 700th career victory last season at the UNCG Invitational.
- In her 24 seasons of coaching, Kathy Riley has posted 22 consecutive seasons above the .500 mark. Her only two seasons below .500 were Riley's first two seasons at Mount Olive.
- Longwood picked up its sixth all-time win against a ranked opponent in the final game of the Aloha Tournament, defeating then-No. 15 California. It marked the fourth-highest ranked opponent that Longwood has defeated in softball in the Division I era.
- Longwood softball signed six standout student-athletes in the early signing period for the 2019 season.

### Notes

- Since Kathy Riley took over prior to the 1998 season, Longwood has dominated the all-time series against the Flames going 33-14 in that span.
- Longwood was the last team to sweep a season set between the two rivals, doing so in back-to-back seasons in 2014 and again in 2015.
- The back-to-back sweeps saw a six-game streak in favor of the Lancers, one shy of the record seven-straight wins from 2004-07.
- Liberty took the first five games of the series and had a seven-game streak between 1995 and 2000, but Longwood has dominated with a 33-12 margin since the turn of the century.
- Longwood head coach Kathy Riley has had the upper hand since Dot Richardson was named Liberty's head coach in July 2013, winning 12 of the 15 head-to-head meetings.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Backed by contributions throughout the lineup and strong pitching from **Sydney Gay**, Longwood won both midweek games -- 2-1 Tuesday versus Hampton and 10-7 Wednesday versus Elon.
- Gay spun a complete game gem Tuesday striking out 11 batters and allowing just one unearned run. She followed that with six strikeouts across five innings Wednesday to pick up her 15th and 16th wins of the season.
- Tuesday saw the Lancers score both runs in the first inning and hang on down the stretch for a 2-1 victory over future Big South foe Hampton.
- The bats came alive Wednesday as the Lancers improved to 3-0 when scoring 10-plus runs this season. The Lancers scored five runs in the bottom of the first and scored in five of their first six at-bats for the midweek win.
- Senior first baseman **Kelsey Sweeney** earned her first start after missing the first two months of the season recovering from injury. Sweeney got the scoring started for the Lancers with a three-run, bases-clearing double.
- In Wednesday's win, six different Lancers scored and eight collected hits as **Karleigh Donovan** led the way with a 3-for-4 day at the plate.

## SCOUTING THE FLAMES

- Liberty enters the weekend as the lone Big South team unbeaten in league play with a 9-0 record.
- Autumn Bishop and reigning Big South Freshman of the Year Amber Bishop lead the way offensively for Liberty as Autumn is batting .395 and Amber hitting .375. The twins have combined for 29 doubles, eight home runs and 51 RBI through 37 contests.
- Reigning Big South Pitcher of the Year Julia DiMartino shoulders most of the load in the circle with a 17-5 record and 2.30 ERA across 130.2 innings pitched.
- Liberty leads the conference with a .308 team batting average and sits second behind Longwood with their 2.60 team ERA.

- Five different Lancers carry streaks into the weekend against Liberty. **Kaylynn Batten** leads the team with a 12-game reached base streak while **Jordan Clark** and **Destiny Martinez** hold three-game hitting streaks.

- Senior utility star **Krista Kelly** joined a growing list of Longwood softball players to be featured on ESPN's flagship SportsCenter Top 10 plays over the weekend.
- Kelly's diving grab in the left field corner debuted on the overnight SportsCenter at No. 9 on the list and climbed to the No. 8 spot Sunday morning.
- Teammate and current third baseman **Jessica Smith** made SportsCenter Top 10 in last season's Big South tournament for her running catch that took her through the right field fence.
- Former Lancer shortstop and current Norfolk State assistant coach Emily Murphy also made SportsCenter Top 10 during the Lancers' stay at the 2015 Knoxville NCAA Regional.

## BIG SOUTH DOMINANCE

- In the midst of its sixth season in the Big South, Longwood has been dominant during the first five. The Lancers have won 33 of 41 series against conference opponents.
- Longwood has swept 19 of the three-game series it has played among conference foes, while accumulating a 91-33 regular season record since joining the league.
- The lone team that has posted a winning record during the regular season is Coastal Carolina, who moved to the Sun Belt prior to the 2016-17 academic year. Winthrop is the only current Big South program to earn a series sweep against Longwood.

**AMONG THE BEST IN THE NATION**

- Longwood has achieved elite status and has become one of the more dominant non-Power Five softball programs in the nation since the start of the 2013 season.
- Since 2013, Longwood has won 207 games with three 40-win seasons in 2013, 2014 and 2016. The 207 wins rank 11th among non-Power-Five members in the nation in that time span.
- Longwood has become the all-time winningest team in Big South history in the NCAA Tournament with their five wins, surpassing the three wins by Coastal Carolina and Radford. In addition, the Lancers are the first-ever Big South team to win at least one game in the NCAA Tournament in three consecutive seasons.
- Longwood ranks 11th among non-Power Five opponents with the 207 victories over the last five seasons. In that stretch, Longwood has not won fewer than 30 games and has three 40-win seasons to its credit.

**WINS AGAINST TOP COMPETITION**

- Head coach Kathy Riley hasn't been shy about scheduling top competition throughout her tenure at Longwood. Riley has guided the Lancers to six victories against nationally-ranked competition in the school's nine seasons in the Division I era.
- Georgia is the highest ranked opponent the Lancers have defeated in the program's history. The Bulldogs were ranked No. 8 when the Lancers earned a 7-5 victory on March 11, 2011.

**WHERE'S KRISTA?**

- Longwood's **Krista Kelly** has become a versatile player for head coach Kathy Riley. While starting 54 of 57 games last season, Kelly started at four different positions in the field. In addition, the Maryland product also served as the DP in one game.
- This season, Kelly has played solely in left field after being moved around the diamond throughout her career
- Shortstop was the seventh different position that Kelly has seen playing time throughout her career. She played three games at the position last season, before moving to center field in the tournament finale.
- Kelly learned the catching position throughout the fall 2015 and opened the 2016 season as Longwood's starting catcher. However, due to team needs, she moved to second base where she played nine contests.
- The junior received her first career start in the outfield in Longwood's 2-1 win over Northwestern State in the 2016 Bulldog Slamboree. It marked her first career start in the outfield across any level of competition in which she has played.
- The Rockville, Md., product was named 2016 Honorable Mention All-Big South in the outfield despite the lack of experience at the position.
- In addition, Kelly made nine starts during her rookie campaign at the hot corner at third base and was used as Longwood's primary third baseman last season.

**SCHEDULING THE BEST**

- Longwood has made a habit of scheduling some of the top teams in the nation. This season the Lancers will play three teams that earned preseason rankings, including BYU, California and James Madison.
- The Lancers will take on five teams from Power Five conferences – four from the ACC and one from the PAC-12. For the fifth consecutive year, Longwood will play North Carolina, Virginia and Virginia Tech, while also facing a Duke squad that will be in its first season of softball in program history. In addition, the Lancers will play PAC-12 powerhouse California, who finished last season 23rd in the final RPI rankings.
- Longwood's non-conference opponents combined for more than 550 wins a season ago with 12 of those teams finishing with a record of .500 or better. In addition, the Lancers will play six games against five different teams that made the 2017 NCAA Tournament.

## SENIOR CLASS LOOKING TO 4-PEAT

- Longwood's senior class -- Krista Kelly, Haleigh Kilby, Sydney Mundell, Kelsey Sweeney and Glenn Walters -- are looking to win their fourth consecutive Big South Championship with the Lancers.
- The group has been part of unparalleled success with the Lancers since arriving to Farmville prior to the 2015 season. They enter their final campaign in Blue and White having won 105 games.
- Longwood's senior class has helped the Lancers win three Big South Tournament Championships, two Big South Regular Season Championships, five games in the NCAA Tournament and advance to two straight NCAA Regional Championship games.
- The group is one of eight programs across the country vying for a fourth straight conference crown, joined by BYU, Fordham, Florida A&M, Florida State, North Dakota State, Oklahoma and USC Upstate.

## IN ELITE COMPANY

- Longwood's head coach Kathy Riley is among the top coaches in the country. She ranks among the top 50 in the nation among coaches in career winning percentage, wins and winningest coaches of all-time.
- Riley entered the season 39th among Division I's all-time wins leaders with 735 in her illustrious career. She entered the season 38th all-time among active coaches in terms of wins while ranking 45th all-time with a .621 winning percentage.
- In her 24 seasons of coaching, Riley has only had two teams finish below the .500 mark while none of her 20 previous Longwood teams have finished below .500.

## LANCERS TAKE ON ALOHA STATE

- Longwood played a pair of tournaments across a two-week span in Hawai'i earlier this season, playing top teams in the nation such as then-No. 15 Cal, perennial mid-major power James Madison and preseason ranked BYU.
- The Lancers went 6-4 across the pair of tournaments while collecting wins against Cal and a win against James Madison.
- In addition to softball, the Lancers had opportunities to snorkel, go to a luau and hike along Hawai'i coastline and mountains.

## LANCERS TABBED TO 4-PEAT

- Longwood was picked to capture its third straight Big South Championship in five seasons by the league's head coaches. It marked the second straight season Longwood has been projected as the league champion.

# KATHY RILEY

Longwood softball head coach Kathy Riley is set to begin her 21st season at the helm of the Lancer softball program in the 2017-18 season. Throughout her storied career, Riley has posted an overall coaching record of 757-459-1 while notching a 670-377-1 since taking over the Lancer softball program prior to the 1998 season, including a record of .500 or better in each of her 20 seasons.

In addition to her coaching duties, Riley was appointed Special Advisor to the Director of Athletics in December, 2017. In that role, she aids Longwood's director of athletics and athletics administration by serving four key functions: acting as a liaison between coaching staffs and administration for the purpose of success communication that fosters positive movement; project implementation through fundraising and friend-raising initiatives; consultant to the athletics director in leadership matters; and advising the administration in matters of the student-athlete experience.

Riley has thrust Longwood onto the national stage through the success of her softball program, taking the Lancers to three NCAA Regionals in 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017 and winning the Big South Championship in all four of those seasons. Longwood has never posted a record below the .500 mark under Riley and reached 20 wins 19 times, 30 wins 12 times and 40 wins three times, including the 2016 squad that went 40-20 and advanced to the program's first NCAA Regional Championship game.

Since Longwood has joined the Big South in 2012-13, Riley has coached two NFCA All-Americans, Megan Baltzell and Brooke Short, and has seen four different players named to the NFCA All-South-east Region team. In addition, Short (2013) and Baltzell (2015) have each been named Big South Female Athlete of the Year during Riley's tenure.

With every NCAA Tournament berth, Riley's teams have ventured closer to an NCAA Super Regional. In the program's historic first visit to an NCAA Regional in 2013, the Lancers suffered back-to-back losses for a quick exit from the Knoxville Regional. Longwood's next trip, which was a return to Knoxville in 2015, featured another historic first when the Lancers upset Commonwealth rival Virginia Tech for the school's first-ever Division I NCAA Tournament win. One year later, the Lancers earned victories against ACC foe North Carolina and Princeton at the Harrisonburg Regional on the same day to advance to the NCAA Regional Championship series against nationally-ranked James Madison.

Riley won back-to-back Big South Coach of the Year awards during the 2015 and 2016 seasons in which the Lancers won both the Big South regular season and tournament championships in dominant fashion.

Last season saw the Lancers get off to an uncharacteristic slow start, sitting in last place in the Big South standings in the middle of the season. However, Longwood won nine of their final 10 games of the regular season to earn the three seed and proceeded to go 4-1 to win their third consecutive Big South crown. Returning to the Knoxville Regional as the four-seed, the Lancers dispatched Ohio State and USC Upstate in a doubleheader to earn a second straight trip to the NCAA Regional final.

In 2016, the Lancers reeled in a shower of awards, including Elizabeth McCarthy earning her second-straight Big South Pitcher of Year honor and Sydney Gay being named the Big South Tournament MVP after pitching five consecutive games and not allowing a single run in 24.2 innings. Thanks to the pair of pitchers, Longwood's ERA

ranked in the NCAA's top-20 by the end of the season.

Posting a 34-25 overall record, Riley's team enjoyed a historic 2015 season that saw the squad accomplish a number of firsts, including Riley earning her first Big South Coach of the Year honor. Behind a 20-4 regular season conference record, Longwood captured the school's first Big South Regular Season Title. The Lancers became the conference's second program to capture Coach of Year, Player of the Year (Megan Baltzell) and Pitcher of the Year (Elizabeth McCarthy) in the same season. The Lancers went on to capture the program's second Big South Championship in a three-year span and entered the NCAA Tournament as one of the nation's hottest teams with a 14-game winning streak. Earning a bid into the Knoxville Regional, Longwood captured the school's first win in the NCAA Tournament on May 16, 2015, as the squad defeated Virginia Tech in eight innings.

Under Riley's watch, Baltzell went from a little-known recruit to becoming the greatest player to don a Longwood uniform from the 2012-15 seasons. During Baltzell's time at Longwood, Riley coached her to 11 school records, four conference records -- despite being eligible in just her final three seasons that Longwood was a member of the league. In addition, Baltzell ended her Lancer career inside the

top-10 in NCAA history in career home runs with 76, while ranking inside the top-three nationally in two of her four years.

Riley's squad posted the second of back-to-back seasons of 40+ wins in the spring of 2014, as Longwood notched a 40-16 overall record. Riley picked up her 600th career coaching victory on March 22 with a 3-0 home victory against Winthrop. Baltzell was named the Big South Player of the Year and was named to the NFCA All-Southeast Region Team. The squad had two 15-game winners, including McCarthy (20) and Libby Morris (17). Longwood entered the Big South Tournament as the No. 2 seed after posting a 17-6 mark in conference play during the regular season.

Riley guided the Lancers to a program-best 41-20 record in 2013, garnering her 500th coaching victory at Longwood with a 4-2 decision against Gardner-Webb on May 10, 2013. The team won its first-ever Big South Conference Championship and made its first appearance at the Division I NCAA Regionals. The most successful and the longest tenured coach in the history of the Longwood program, Riley tutored three NFCA First-Team All-Southeast Region selections, as well as a pair of All-American honorees in 2013, as well. Her overall collegiate coaching record is 591-358-1, including four years at Mount Olive (N.C.) College.

The Lancers finished 2012 with a final record of 29-26, marking their 12th year with at least 25 wins under Riley. In 2011, Longwood compiled a final record of 37-13 and Riley was named the 2011 Virginia Sports Information Directors Association (VaSID) Coach of the Year for her efforts.

Longwood finished 36-16 during 2010 and 23-23 in 2009, the only non-winning season during Riley's tenure, though still a .500 effort. The Lancers finished 27-18 in 2008, following a 21-18 campaign in 2007 that completed the four-year Division I Reclassification. Longwood finished 27-19 in 2006 for its eighth-straight 25-win season, while in 2005, the Lancers were 32-20 for their fourth consecutive 30-win effort as Riley was named the 2005 Division I Independent Coach of the Year. It was also the program's first year playing a full Division I schedule.

Longwood was 37-13 in 2004 against a predominantly Division II schedule, its third-straight 37-win season. The Lancers finished 37-6 in 2003, claiming both the Carolinas-Virginia Athletic Conference (CVAC) regular season and CVAC Tournament Championships. Longwood made its second consecutive NCAA Regional Tournament appearance that year as well. The Lancers were 37-14 in 2002, winning the program's first CVAC Tournament Championship to earn their first NCAA Regional Tournament appearance with Riley garnering CVAC Coach of the Year honors.

Longwood finished 26-14-1 in 2001, following a 34-23 record in 2000

while finishing as CVAC Tournament runners-up. The Lancers compiled a school-record of 38-15 in 1999, while the program was 22-18 during Riley's first year in 1998.

Prior to Longwood, Riley served as head coach at Mount Olive from 1993-97, gaining CVAC Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and 1995. She coached volleyball as well and was the 1994 CVAC Coach of the Year in that sport. Before that, Riley coached basketball and softball at Goldsboro (N.C.) High School for one year following eight years with the Houston (Texas) Flames AAU women's basketball team that won two National AAU Championships.

In addition to her coaching accomplishments, Riley has enjoyed quite a remarkable individual career in athletics. She was the 1981 Broderick Cup National Softball Player of the Year at East Carolina University, leading ECU to a No. 1 national ranking while garnering 1st-team All-America honors. Riley later played on the gold medal-winning team at the 1990 Olympic Sports Festival.

Riley is a member of the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA), and was inducted into the United States Specialty Sports Association (USSSA) Softball Hall of Fame on November 12, 1999. She received the 2000 USSSA DeBeer-Richard H. Pollak Memorial Outstanding Sportswoman of the Year award as well. Riley has played on five national champion softball teams during the summer months, gaining All-America honors seven times.

In basketball, Riley was a Street & Smith magazine preseason All-American and North Carolina Athlete of the Year in 1981. ECU was a top-20 program that year while advancing to the NCAA Tournament. She scored over 1,800 career points while at ECU and Middle Tennessee State University, and earned tryouts for the 1980 United States Olympic Women's Basketball Team and the 1978 Pan American Games team. Riley was a finalist for the 1980 Olympic team, and later played professionally with the Houston Shamrocks of the Women's American Basketball Association during 1983-84.

A native of Dayton, Ohio, Riley earned her Bachelor of Science degree in physical education from East Carolina in 1981 after a transfer from Middle Tennessee State in 1979. She earned her Master of Education degree in physical education: psychology/sociology from North Texas State University in 1982.
