

The Longwood University women's soccer team, along with the athletics department, welcomes everyone to the all-new Athletics Complex. The Lancers, second-year members of the United Soccer Conference (USC, women's soccer-only), are hosting Big South Conference member VMI for tonight's SENIOR NIGHT match. Longwood is competing this season in the final year of its four-year NCAA Division I Reclassification toward official certification in September 2007.

Longwood is coached by 13th-year head coach Todd Dyer '93 (144-80-11), assisted by third-year assistant coach Steve Brdarski. VMI is coached by second-year head coach Bryan Williams, assisted by Tresy Ross.

Longwood enters the contest tonight following a 2-1 road loss at Coastal Carolina on Monday as the host Chanticleers scored two second-half goals for the win. The Lancers are led in scoring by senior Tiffany Crane with her five goals and three assists for 13 points, followed closely by freshmen Colleen Thamm (5g, 2a, 12p), Kaylyn Mahon (5g, 1a, 11p), and Sarah Fening (5g, 10p).

Longwood will travel to South Carolina to play USC East rival South Carolina State University next Friday, Oct. 27, at 7 p.m..
